- Completed our 219th house in December 2022
- Provided homes for 32 people in 2022
- 4 Habitat homeowners paid off mortgages in 2022
- 1,047 volunteers provided nearly 11,000 hours of service
- Homeowners paid over \$265,000 in property taxes
- Over 40,000 people shopped in the ReStore
- Nearly 100 businesses, churches and organizations contributed money, materials or volunteers.

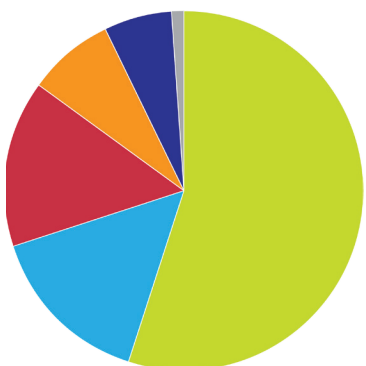
Resource Stewardship
